Fiber sources

The paper grades are produced from virgin fibers and by reusing paper mill's own broke.
 All virgin fibers are elementary chlorine free (ECF) bleached pulps.
 All pulp grades hold at least a FSC-Controlled Wood claim. Some pulp grades have a FSC-Mix and/or PEFC % claim.
 All pulps originate from wood sources that are accordance with the Regulation (EU) No 995/2010 laying down the obligations of operators who place timber and timber products on the market.

Substances content

During the production process, following substances are not intentionally added or deliberately used in the paper formulation. This information is based upon information provided by our raw material suppliers:

- substances as defined in Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous materials in electrical and electronic equipment,
- substances as defined in Regulation (EU) 2017/821 laying down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas,
- food allergens as defined in Regulation (EU) 1169/2011 on the provision of food information to consumers,
- genetically modified organisms as defined in EU (https://ec.europa.eu/food/plant/gmo_en),
- materials of direct animal origin including those causing Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) and Creutzfeldt Jacob Disease (JCD),
- MOSH / MOAH
- polybrominated biphenyls,
- diphenylether,
- phthalates,
- bisphenol A and bisphenol S,
- fluorocarbon based compounds,
- synthetic nanoparticles.

General legislation and regulation

For the production of the abovementioned paper grades only substances are used which are in accordance with EC 1907/2006 Annex V / Article 2 (7)(b) (REACH), exempted from registration or will be / have already been registered by our suppliers.

None of our raw materials used for papermaking contain substances, which are restricted by REACH Annex XVII or are defined substances of very high concern (SVHC, "**Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern**" in its most recent update).

The paper grades are in accordance with the European Parliament and Council Directive 94/62/EC of 20. December 1994 on packaging and packaging waste.

In terms of recyclability the above mentioned paper grades can be recycled within the paper recycling process loop.
